

A Guide to use Classes in 2021

AND PERMITTED CHANGES OF USE

Introduction

The Town and Country Planning (Use Classes) Order 1987 (as amended) effectively categorises different land uses into certain classes. Change between uses within the same class does not constitute development and therefore does not necessitate planning permission. The Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) (England) Order 2015 (as amended) provides for some permitted development rights allowing the change of use between two different classes, subject to certain conditions, limitations and/or a prior approval process.

Significant reform to these use classes and permitted development rights became effective from 1 September 2020, with further new and revised permitted development rights due to be introduced on 31 July 2021.

This guide provides an overview of the previous use classes up to 1 September 2020, which are still used for the purposes of interpreting permitted development rights until 31 July 2021, and identifies where those land uses are categorised under the reformed Use Classes Order. In addition, this guide will explain the changes of use for which permitted development rights exist.

This guide is intended as an overview only and should be read with regard to The Town and Country Planning (Use Classes) Order 1987 (as amended) and the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) (England) Order 2015 (as amended) for limitations, restrictions, conditions or any requirements for prior approval.
